SHOW COMMITTEE: The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries.

Pony Division: Any animal not over 148 centimeters without shoes, or 149 centimeters with shoes are classified as ponies. A copy of the Federation Standard or Temporary Measurement Certificate must be submitted with the entry for each pony possessing a Measurement Certificate and competing in Dressage or Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes limited to ponies. If a pony is not in possession of a fully and correctly completed Measurement Certificate, the Competition Management may order the pony to be measured by an eligible Dressage Technical Delegate and the Competition Veterinarian and/or a Judge, pursuant to GR505, GR506, and GR508.

ENTRIES: Accepted on first come, first served basis, based on (readable) postmark. Post entries (postmarked after closing date) will be accepted on a space available basis with late fee. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established. Wait list will be maintained through July 16, 2008. Current 2008 RMDS entry form must be used. Proof of memberships and horse registrations must be included with entry. If riding freestyle include a copy of qualifying test. If entry is incomplete, horse/rider combination will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received. Times: provisional times will be mailed in your SASE. Official times will be posted at the show office. Numbers required at all times when horse is outside of stall. Entry form required if schooling only.

REFUNDS: Up to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to July 16, 2008, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. Qualifying fees and drug fee (if horse is not on show grounds) refunded. Stabling fees refunded if cancellation is on or before July 16, 2008. During competition days **no refunds including Acts of God. Office fee is nonrefundable.**

AWARDS: Trophy to first place; ribbons through 6th place. High Point Awards. USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal for Class #208 - competitor with the highest score of at least 58% or better (must be USDF member).

STABLING: Permanent 10 x 10 stalls with mats and full doors or permanent 8 x 16 stalls with Dutch doors, bedding required but not provided. Shavings available on grounds, place orders in show office. **Stabling available at noon on Thurs July 17, 2008.** If you prefer one set of stabling over another, please note.

ARENAS: Two outdoor 20 x 60-meter show arena, two outdoor warm-up arenas; all sand mix footing. (Intro/Training Level classes may be held in 20 x 40-meter arena.) Arenas watered and worked throughout show. Lungeing area near barns. **Show arena open for schooling Thursday and Friday afternoon/evening until show office closes.**

VET/FARRIER: On call, numbers posted in show office and stables.

EMT: On-Site EMTS.

CONCESSIONS: Food available on premises. The Horse is Sport will be the Tack Vendor.

LODGING: Rodeway Inn (970) 586-5363; Holiday Inn (970) 586-2332; Olympus Lodge (970) 586-8141 Reserve lodging early to get the best rates and availability.

OTHER: Dogs must be leashed at all times.
