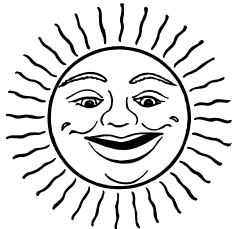

Entries: Use the 2005 RMDS entry form. Make checks payable to Aspen Ridge and send entries together with check to Secretary. All entries refunded except office fee if withdrawn before closing date. After closing date, only with a VET excuse AND if ride is filled! Show will be held in the Outdoor Arena (20 x 60 meters). Outdoor and Indoor areas are available for warm up. Indoor arena (20x40) will be used as show arena if weather is bad. Riders with disabilities please state disability on entry and waive office fee. Concessions not available - fast food nearby. **NO DOGS** - \$50 Fine for violators.

Directions: From North: I-25 south to Exit 161, Monument. East on Hwy 105, 4.5mi to Roller Coaster Road. Right on Roller Coaster Rd, 1.6mi to Higby Rd, turn right, first left is Aspen Ridge Farm. From South: I-25 north to Exit 158, Baptist Rd. Right and immediately left onto Struthers Rd. 2mi to Higby Rd, turn right. 3.3mi to Aspen Ridge Farm; on right just after Happy Landing Drive (!).

Awards: Ribbons through sixth place; special prize for "Overall High Point of the day"
