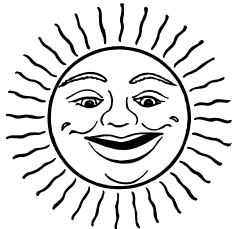

Dear Club Members

Hopefully all of you have found some good remedies to deal with that - we are having the first West Nile Cases in the state - so make sure you stay on top of your vaccinations. After your spring vaccination - Littleton Large Animal Clinic recommends a booster in July or August.

According to several people that are actively showing - there seems to be some nasty flu going around - again if you are planning on showing, make sure you boost your vaccinations. Again according to LLAC you should boost Flu and Rhino about every 3 to 4 months if you have a performance horse, pleasure horses are fine with a 6 month schedule which most of you are on anyway - with your spring and fall vaccinations.

CSDA is having Show No 3 in our series - this coming weekend at Latigo. Saturday is the schooling show, RMDS recognized show is on Sunday. Our 4th and last show in the series will take place in August at Aspen Ridge - Aug 27 and 28 with L-Graduate Beth Geier as our judge.

## CSDA June 20, General Meeting Minutes

\*The meeting was held at Simone Windler s downtown office. Attendance sheet was signed by Greta Johnson, Maria Cicile Lee, Simone Windler, Heather Petersen, and Jane McBride

\*RMDS and the Bush family hearing against CSDA is set for July 12th in Denver. Member and lawyer Jane Fredman, has agreed to consult with the current board members on this issue.

\*The agenda for the meeting was then followed

\*The club needs to move the judge s stand from Emmy s place. A couple of people volunteered their location, but it will be another month or so before they know when and where they can move it. We need to check with Penrose to see about storing it where our arenas are stored.

\*A vote was taken to have the permanent meeting place at Simone Windler s office. A map with directions will be included in the next newsletter.

\*There is a need for a mailing address for the club, since the last P.O. Box was let go. A P.O. Box will be acquired at the post office on Powers and Galley. Heather volunteered to get the box.

\*Treasurer s report \$9,000 June balance, \$16,604 income from May show, \$14,978 expenses showing a profit of \$1,626. We still owe the caterer for the exhibitor s party food.

\*The Evening Under the Lights at 62 paying people for the night. The evening did not make money, but was also considered the exhibitor s party. The Zoo, the Penrose facility and the Range Riders were cited as possible non-profits to partner with next year. We need a chairperson for the Evening Under The Lights for 2006.

\*Sun Prairie s show has moved to the week after our CSDA May Show. Entries for our show will suffer because of this. It was suggested that CSDA decrease to a one ring show next year. The show for the Cure the week before our show and Sun Prairie s move has made this the logical choice. We are discussing adding a national show for rider s with disabilities next year, which will put us back to two rings.

\*The Footing at Penrose was excellent this year. We have heard that some exhibitor s stay away from our show because of poor footing. We need to advertise that we had an excellent rating on our footing this year.

\*CSDA has picked-up the USEF and USDF dates from the Sun Prairie July show. We are discussing running another one ring show, site to be decided. Penrose has outdoor arenas available on those dates.

\*The CSDA schooling shows have been good fundraisers for the club. We want to know from the membership if we should do them again next year.

\*There is an instructor final testing April 20-23, 2006 at Penrose. Horses and riders are needed.

\*April 8 & 9, 2006 there is a Stephan Peters & Janet Brown clinic.

\* CiCi will be working on getting some clinics . It was approved that the club will subsidize the clinic by \$400.00 in order to keep the costs down for the memberships.
