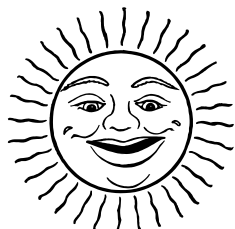

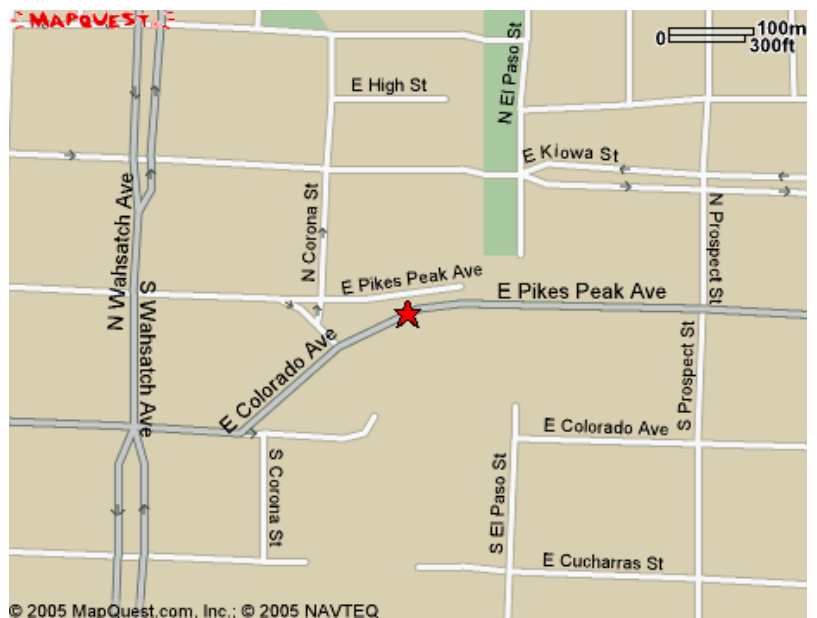

CSDA February 21, General Meeting Minutes

The meeting started at 7:00 at Simone Windeler's office. Dr. Woodall gave a very informative presentation about Radiographs. Aspen Ridge Equine Hospital had a wonderful slide show presentation of x-ray. Dr. Woodall explained the differences between Zero Radiology, Digital and Conventional x-rays. Eventually all x-rays will be digital as they show more definition, but the equipment is very expensive.

Simone called a meeting to order. The May show was briefly discussed. Judy Carnick volunteered to be the volunteer coordinator for this year's May events.

Bids were called for to run 2007 CSDA shows and events. A proposal was presented by Heather, Simone and Jane. This was passed by the members.

Votes were taken on the changes proposed in the last newsletter regarding the by-laws and the year end awards. All passed except the proposal for changing the Breed awards for horse of the year. The change was made to require five rides instead of the past eight rides to qualify. Scores earned by multiple riders on the same horse failed. The horse must be ridden by the same rider in all five rides to be eligible.

Entries: Use the 2006 RMDS entry form – send separate entries for schooling shows and RMDS shows with separate checks. Make checks payable to CSDA and send entries together with check to Secretary. All entries refunded except office fee if withdrawn before closing date. After closing date, only with a VET excuse AND if ride is filled! If snow, refund policy will be reconsidered. Show arenas will be 20X60 – Intro and Training levels may be held in 20X40. Times are tentative and will be available 4-5 days prior to show. Will send times is SASE enclosed, otherwise times will be available at www.csdressage.org or by phoning secretary.

Awards: Ribbons to 6th place all divisions. Ties broken if collective marks differ, otherwise left tied. RMDS and Schooling Series Champions and Reserve Champions given for each division with highest average percentage (minimum two shows required – two RMDS and/or two schooling. Dressage at the Peak II Summer Warm-Up included in series.

Directions to Penrose: I-25 to Colorado Springs. At "Cimarron" (Highway 24) exit 141, go west to 8th Street at stoplight. Go south on 8th to "Rio Grande" (stoplight intersection near Wal-Mart). Turn west (right) up the hill to entrance of Penrose Equestrian Center on left. Bear left towards indoor arena. Show office is in brick building adjacent to the indoor arena.

Directions to Aspen Ridge: I-25 to Exit 161, Monument. East on Hwy 105, 4.5 mi to Roller Coaster Road. Right on Roller Coaster Rd, 1.6 mi to Higby Rd, turn right, first left is Aspen Ridge Farm. NO DOGS PLEASE!!
