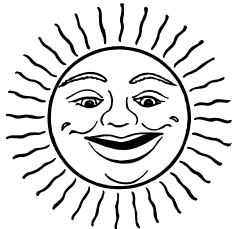

The meeting was held at Simone Windler's downtown office.

CSDA financials: We had a beginning balance of \$7,132.59 on Aug. 16. An ending balance of \$8,481.72 on Sept. 15. The shows for next year were discussed. June 30/July recognized show the judge will be Kristie Wysocki and Marianne Ludwig. Cici is secretary and Simone W. is manager. Deeda is T.D.

A Sara Martin clinic on Oct. 6, there are eight rides. October 7, there are 7 rides. Five slots left.

Toine Hoft clinic has moved to Douglas County Fairgrounds. Volunteer for Championships!

Volunteer hours, people can use up to 4 hrs. for clinics sponsored by CSDA, depending on the clinic. Each volunteer buck is worth \$5.00. Vol. hrs. are good for one calendar year, exception for following year camp.
