Fees:

Class fee per: \$25

Office fee: \$15 (non-refundable)

Day stall: \$15

Overnight Stall: \$25

Entries: Use the 2008 RMDS entry form (available at www.rmids.org). Make checks payable to Whispering Winds and send entries together with check to secretary. All entries refunded except office fee if withdrawn before closing date. After closing date only with a VET excuse AND if filled. Will send times if SASE enclosed, otherwise times will be available by phoning or e-mailing secretary.

Refunds: Up to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. Office fee is non refundable.

Awards: Ribbons to 6th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties.

Series Awards: This is a series. Overall winner in each division will receive an embroidered cooler at the end of the series. Overall winner determined based on a golf score. That means you will receive 6 points for every win in every class. The open rider, Adult Amateur and Jr/YR with the overall highest points will be the winner.

Directions: Take I-25 to Monument. Go east on Hwy 105 to Hwy 83. Turn South on Hwy 83. Whispering Winds is the first driveway on the right (you will see the big red indoor arena and barn). Dress is casual, however a boot with heel and ASTM safety helmet are required.
